### **2010 ALBERTA CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL FOUNDATION CHARITY SHOOT – ANOTHER TERRIFIC SUCCESS!**

Well, BTSA has done it again. On June 12, we held another successful charity shoot to raise money for the Alberta Children's Hospital Foundation.

While this year marked our 17<sup>th</sup> annual event, this year's fund-raiser was held for the first time at the Homestead Range.

We had 16 shooters come out, down a bit in numbers from previous years, but those that came out appeared to have a great time (have a look at the photos on the next page)

Even with the reduced numbers, BTSA came through again for the kids at the Children's Hospital - raising more than \$3,500 this year. BTSA has now donated close to \$40,000 to the Children's Hospital Foundation since the event began.

We ran a pistol challenge, a .22 rifle challenge and a three-position youth fun shoot to get the kids used to pistol, rifle and shotgun handling - all, of course, under RSO supervision.

Joe B. got first pick of the prizes, having brought in the most donations (more than \$1,600). Next to pick was Jody S. who finished first in the rifle competition.
